VINTAGE: 2021

VARIETAL: 55% Graciano, 45% Syrah

APPELLATION: Central Coast

VINEYARDS: Dead End, Old Potrero, Spanish Springs, White Hawk ALC: 15.2%

FERMENTATION: 100% destemmed in 1.5 ton open top fermentors

TASTING NOTES

The 2021 Journeyman Red is an intriguing blend of Graciano and Syrah from four spectacular central coast vineyards. Its aromas of ripe **strawberry**, **cedar**, **wild rose**, and **pink peppercorn** strike a balance between playful allure and refined sophistication. Subtle hints of **tobacco** and **leather** in this wine evoke the comfort of a plush armchair in a cozy, warmly-lit study.
